Chiaravalle Montessori is seeking a full-time qualified and experienced Spanish Teacher (PK-8) to join our teaching team for the 2019-2020 school year.

The Spanish Teacher will develop and implement a creative, differentiated curriculum for multi-age classrooms (ages 3-14) for Preschool through 8th grade. This person will collaborate with classroom teachers to thoughtfully integrate the Spanish curriculum into homeroom classes via “push in” sessions, formal classes and/or other structured visits.

Classroom schedule responsibilities include:

- "Push in" weekly line time (Early Childhood, Lower Elementary grade levels)
- Formal class once a week (Lower Elementary grade level)
- Formal class twice a week by grade (Upper Elementary, Middle School levels)
- Prepare and provide learning materials for children to explore and discover independently as to reinforce class lessons
- Spanish "studio" classes (3) offered throughout the school year as part of the After School program targeting Preschool level children
- Formal 45 minute classes three times a week (Middle School level)
- Complete regular assessments for 4th-8th grade students to give feedback and assess learning

Education and Qualifications:

- A bachelor's degree in Education and/or Spanish and Montessori or Professional Educator certification is required.
- At least two years experience teaching Spanish is required.
- Experience as a Head Teacher is preferred.
- Experience teaching in a Montessori school is a plus.
- Must have proven skills in differentiation, curriculum design and class management.
- Excellent observation, interpersonal, active listening, verbal/written communication, organizational and prioritization skills are essential.

This position is a full-time position (35-40 hours) and qualifies for full benefits.
